HDCAM recording and playback - 1080/50i, 1080/59.94i, 1080/25P, 1080/29.97P, 1080/23.98P and 1080/24P

Digital Betacam and MPEG IMX playback

Up and Down-conversion capabilities with selectable picture modes. Output 480/59.94i and 576/50i signals in SD-SDI or analog composite. Up-convert to either 1080i or 720P when playing the standard definition formats

Control panel with colour LCD panel which displays audio level meter, time data and playback/recording picture

Slow Motion - DT (Dynamic Tracking) heads will allow broadcast quality pictures to be replayed in the range -1 to x2 speed from HDCAM tapes, and from -1 to x3 speed when replaying MPEG IMX and Digital Betacam cassettes.

Search Functions - Jog and Shuttle Mode. The HDW-D1800P VTR delivers recognizable colour pictures in shuttle mode at speeds of up to 50 times normal playback. Jog operation is also possible at -1 to +2 times normal speed.

Surround sound - Both Dolby-E and AC-3 are handled as standard
